Applying to CHARLOTTE'S hope

We have tried to make the application process to be a resident and to participate in the support recovery program as streamlined as possible. The following five step process describes the process from first contact to moving in.

- step 1* The admission process commences with the submission by the referring family doctor, nurse practitioner or psychiatrist of the "Application for Residency and Recovery Support Program" which is attached. Please follow instructions for return of the form by FAX.
- step 2* Within one week of receipt of the application, a meeting will be arranged with the applicant for an intake assessment at Charlotte's hope in Barrie. During this visit to the home, the applicant will meet with the house manager to become familiar with the support program, select activities of greatest interest, review expectations for behaviour and participation, go over the house rules and the resident agreement.
- step 3* Following the house visit by the applicant and the intake assessment, should both the individual and assessment team agree that the residential experience and support program offers a real opportunity to benefit the applicant's recovery, a formal offer of acceptance and welcome to Charlotte's hope will be made to the applicant.
- step 4* The Applicant will then be presented with the date of the first available opening, make payment arrangements for the resident's share of operating costs and complete all necessary forms.
- step 5* Take up residency on the agreed date and meet staff and fellow house mates.
